ONPA awards 2003 Collegiate Newspaper Contest honors

Corvallis, Ore. – The Oregon Newspaper Publishers Association presented its 2003 Collegiate Newspaper Contest awards to member Oregon college and university newspapers during the association's annual Collegiate Day conference held at Oregon State University in Corvallis Friday, May 2.

Fourteen of ONPA's 21 Collegiate newspapers competed in this year's contest. Together, these newspapers submitted a total of 485 entries.

A group of individuals in the editorial and advertising departments at Oregon's professional newspapers judged the contest April 17.

The judges awarded a total of 134 general excellence, first, second and honorable mention awards.

ONPA, founded in 1887, is a professional association of the state's 88 daily and nondaily paid circulation newspapers.
