**ONPA awards 2004 Collegiate Newspaper Contest honors**

Monmouth, Ore. – The Oregon Newspaper Publishers Association presented its 2004 Collegiate Newspaper Contest awards to member Oregon college and university newspapers during the Oregon Newspaper Foundation's annual Collegiate Day conference held at Western Oregon University in Monmouth, Oregon on Friday, May 7.

Seventeen of ONPA's 21 Collegiate newspapers competed in this year's contest. Together, these newspapers submitted a total of 537 entries.

A group of individuals in the editorial and advertising departments at Oregon's professional newspapers judged the contest April 15.

The judges awarded a total of 154 general excellence, first, second and honorable mention awards. There were 33 Honorable Mention awards, 60 second place awards, and 61 first place awards.

ONPA, founded in 1887, is a professional association of the state's 88 daily and nondaily paid circulation newspapers.
