A government-funded Lifeline Assistance Program.

Qualified low-income residents of Oregon may receive a free phone and monthly allotment of airtime. Lifeline (Oregon Telephone Assistance Program) Assistance is limited to one benefit per household. **To apply, visit www.enroll.accesswireless.com.**

Free phone is provided by Access Wireless. Phone models based on inventory availability. Access Wireless is a service provider for the government-funded Lifeline Assistance Program. Lifeline service is provided by i-wireless LLC, d/b/a Access Wireless, an eligible telecommunications carrier. Lifeline service is non-transferable. Only one Lifeline/OTAP discount consisting of either wireline or wireless service may be received per household. A household is defined for the purposes of the Lifeline program as any individual or group of individuals who live together at the same address and share income, and expenses. Violation of the one-per-household rule constitutes a violation of the FCC rules and will result in the customer's de-enrollment from Lifeline. Only eligible consumers may enroll in the program. Consumers who willfully make a false statement in order to obtain a Lifeline benefit can be punished by fine or imprisonment, or can be barred from the program. Customers may be required to present proper documentation confirming eligibility for the Lifeline program. Your information will be validated against public records and any discrepancies could result in delays to your approval or rejection of service.
